	Why is Richmont the graduate program for you?		
	What does your spiritual life look like?		
	This statement will be examined to determine your writing ability and will be rated according to clarity of thought, grammar, and readability. It will also be used to learn more about you personally.		
3.	Resume		
	Submitted with application or via email including education, work experience, and volunteer work.		
4.	. Official Transcripts		
	One official transcript from all post-secondary institutions attended. Transcripts must be sent directly from the institution. In order to review your file, we must have an official transcript for every institution attended, even if any credits were transferred to another school.
